WANTAGE TOWNSHIP'S CLEAN COMMUNITIES PROGRAM "ADOPT A ROAD"

In return for organizing a roadside litter pick-up in Wantage Township, your group can earn \$12 per hour, per person. Gloves, litter bags, and safety vests are provided.

The participants in your organization will be developing civic pride in performing community service. This hands-on experience will help them understand the negative impact of litter on our environment.

GUIDELINES

Call Ken Karnas @ 862 268-1891 (973 875-5316) to choose a date, time, and **Wantage Township** road.

Arrange for adults to accompany and supervise. Conduct a safety meeting for all participants. **Get written permission for all minors**.

Clean-ups should be conducted only in good weather and during daylight hours.

Every participant *must* wear a safety vest and gloves.

Stay on one side of the road, facing oncoming traffic. Stay out of the roadway.

One adult should be at the front of the line. Another adult should be at the end.

Only adults should handle sharp or unusual objects.

RECYCLE as much as possible.

Keep track of the number of participants, hours worked, and number of bags of garbage and recyclables collected. Call Ken Karnas with the results of your clean-up.

A **W-9 Tax Form** is required before payment for your cleanup can be made. Yearly amounts exceeding \$600 are reported to the IRS. The check will be mailed to the name or organization shown on the W-9.

Dispose of trash appropriately. For especially large clean-ups, trash may be taken to the landfill. Reimbursement will be given for tipping fees upon submission of receipt.
