SHEDS

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Zoning Permit required for all sheds and similar structures.
- 2. Construction Permit required for sheds greater than 200 sq. ft. or 10 feet or greater in height to Use Groups R-2, R-3, R-4, or R-5. All other use groups require permits for any size shed.
- 3. Required footings as per IRC 2015:
- R403.1.4 Minimum depth. Exterior footings shall be placed not less than 12 inches below the undisturbed ground surface. Where applicable, the depth of footings shall also conform to Section R403.1.4.1
- **R403.1.4.1 Frost protection**. Except where otherwise protected from frost, foundation walls, piers and other permanent supports of buildings and structures shall be protected from frost.

Exception: Freestanding buildings meeting <u>all</u> of the following conditions shall not be required to be frost protected:

- 1. Buildings and other structures that represent a low hazard to human life in the event of failure, including but not limited to, agricultural buildings, temporary buildings and minor storage facilities.
- 2. Area of 600 square feet (56 m²) or less for light-framed construction, or 400 square feet (37 m²) or less for other than light-framed construction; and
- 3. Eave height of 10 feet (3048 mm) or less.
