The Wantage Township Board of Health held its regular monthly meeting Wednesday, June 12, 2013 at the Wantage Township Municipal Building, 888 State Route 23 South, Wantage, New Jersey at 7:30 p.m.

Mr. Plaza read the County Health Reports:  
Quick Check investigated specs for an elaborate chlorine residual monitoring device to check for chlorine residuals between the pint of chlorine injection and the carbon unit. It was explained all that is required is a colorimetric test kit (cost about \$50.00) which takes only a few seconds each day to run/record. The unit he proposed was over \$14,000.00. He was advised that someone from the County would assist with the demonstration of how to use kit if he felt that was necessary.

Dave Simmons will be installing a permanent hypo chlorination system and storage tank for disinfection at the Sussex Wantage Swim Club.

After failing their November 2012 water test for total coliform Beemerville Fire Department performed shock chlorination as part of the remedial measures taken.

A resident complained about the large amounts of tree parts and wood at the Sussex Airport from the pipeline clearing operation. The trees will be removed within the month.

Two rental apartments in the Town Center have received their Certificate of Compliance and a septic system on a third building is completed.

The Clove Hill Manor pool was inspected and received a satisfactory rating.

Munchies on the Go, a new food cart, received a satisfactory rating.

The Tennessee Gas Line environmental group reported three minor oil spills, they filed reports with the DEP.

The County was informed of a pressure drop in the Sussex Borough water system, the chlorine residual was checked at Elias Cole and Major League Deli.
