WANTAGE TOWNSHIP

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR QUARRY ROAD

Ordinance No. 2016-10

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer prepared and submitted a Speed Survey for Quarry Road dated September 8, 2016, consisting of summarized findings plus Appendices; and

WHEREAS, the final recommendation of said Speed Survey is that the speed limit of 30 MPH shall be set for Quarry Road and that speed limit signs should be installed; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Wantage finds it in the interest of public safety to establish speed limits for both directions of traffic along the Quarry Road from Sally Harden Road north to the cul-de-sac pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8.b; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has submitted and certified all of the legislative requirements, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(b) and criteria set forth by the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Bureau of Traffic Engineering Investigations has been met; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation of the Township Engineer is that the speed limit for Quarry Road be established at 30 MPH and that the speed limit signs be installed as required by statute and regulations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wantage in the County of Sussex and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Speed Limits.

The speed limits for both directions of traffic along Quarry Road in the Township of Wantage shall be 30 MPH from Sally Harden Road north to the cul-de-sac.

Section 2. Penalties.

Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be subject to a penalty or imprisonment as expressly provided by New Jersey Statute.

Section 3. Severability.

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent or in opposition to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 5. Effective Dates.

This Ordinance will take effect after publication and passage according to law.
