Donna Tomczyk 25 Oil City Road: Mrs. Tomczyk stated a resident called her and said they hear the music from 3.3 miles away.

Ray Tomczyk 25 Oil City Road: Mr. Tomczyk stated this issue has been going on Pre COVID and in the Winter, they have the entrainment confined inside. Mr. Tomczyk stated he contacted the State Police pertaining to the truck traffic on Oil City Road.
